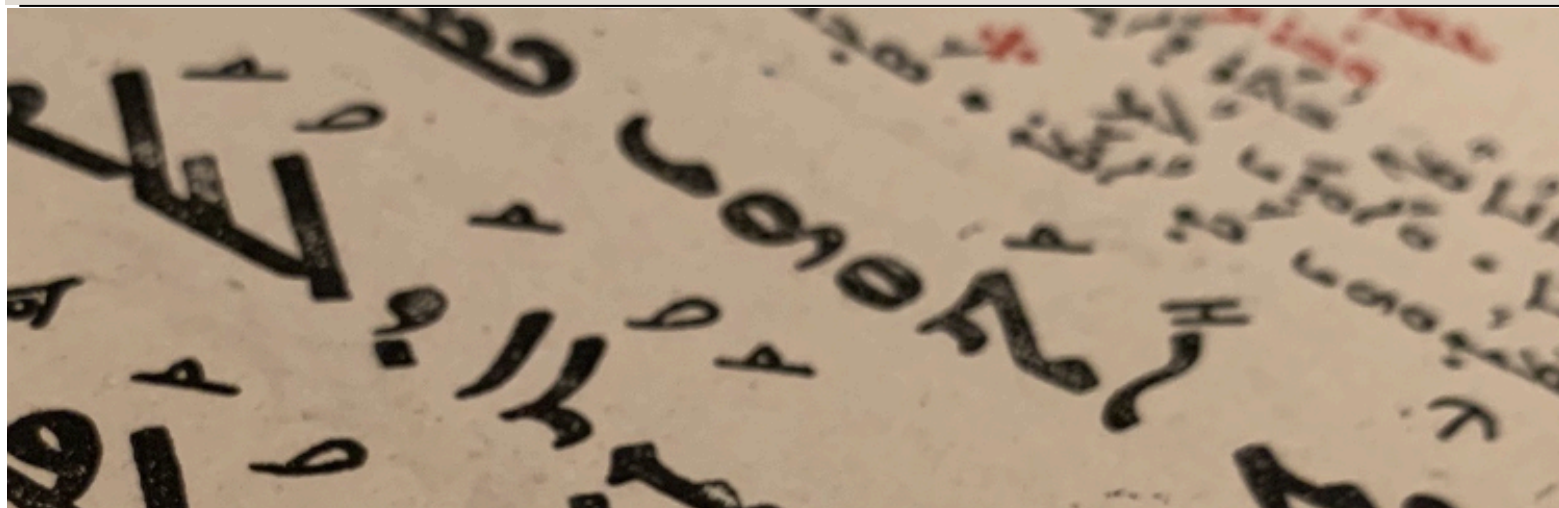


## SIXTH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST

**From the Desk of the Pastor**

In the Maronite Liturgy celebrated by our Church for over one thousand years until the 1970's, before the "Holy for the Holy..." in the Anaphora, the priest prayed the following prayer silently while the deacon admonished the congregation to "Let us all gaze at our God with fear and trembling and beg mercy and compassion from Him."

"Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of Hosts, heaven and earth are full of Thy glory, Thou Who are above the universe and heavens, I raise my eyes to Thee, O God of heaven: as the eyes of the servant is fixed upon his master, and of the handmaid upon her mistress, so are our eyes fixed upon Thee beseeching Thy mercy. Have pity on us, O Lord, and look kindly upon me, according to the abundance of Thy mercy and wash away my sins. Have pity on me, O God, for in Thee is the hope of my salvation, and under the shadow of Thy wings I have taken refuge. Have pity on me, O Lord, for man has taken me from Thee. Deliver me from my enemies and let me be victorious over them. Remember me, O Lord, when Thou shalt enter into Thy Kingdom. The Holy for the Holy..."

In these days where we see societal anxiety, civil unrest and injustice, the desecration and destruction of Christian churches and institutions, and untold other atrocities and crimes against God, we should look to the core of this prayer as our refuge – we are to fix our eyes to our Master in heaven trusting in the abundance of His mercy. We are to take refuge under the shadow of His wings that we might be victorious over those who would rise up against us. May the Lord, through the gift of the Eucharistic Offering, sustain and continue to protect his Holy Church. May He guide her shepherds to always put their flock first and always keep their eyes raised to the One who is abundant in mercy.

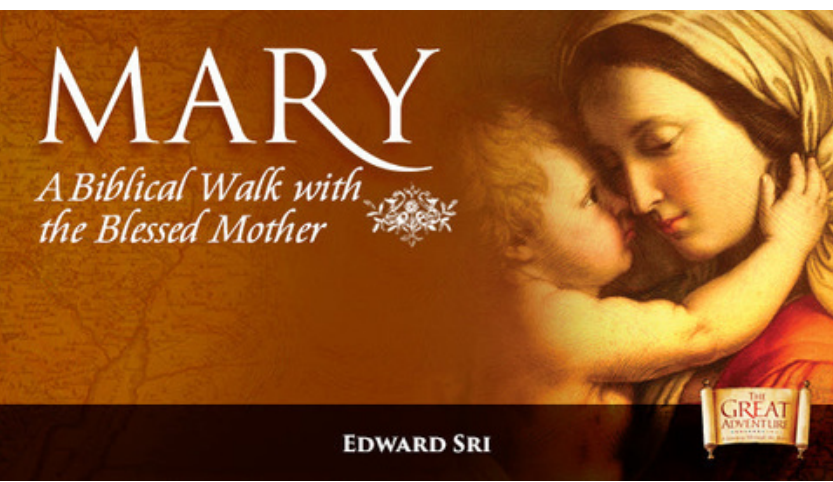
