**From the Desk of the Pastor**

This Sunday we celebrate the Revelation to Joseph concerning the Incarnation of our Lord within the womb of the Mother of God. The Sedro for this feast prays:

*Today we celebrate the feast of your Divine Revelation: The Divine Revelation that Joseph received dispelling his fear. The Divine Revelation that filled all believers with joy. The Divine Revelation that removed every doubt from Joseph regarding the Purest of Virgins.*

This is the feast of the Revelation of the Lord not only to Joseph but to all mankind throughout salvation history. On this day, when Joseph received his Revelation from the Lord, all the previous prophecies, whispers, mysteries, and secrets of the Old Law concerning the coming of the Messiah were fulfilled. This is the last revelation of the Old Covenant. Everything that had been whispered by seers, prophets, and mystical teachers of old finds its purpose and apex in this revelation to a simple carpenter in Nazareth.

Let us also allow this Revelation of the Lord's Coming dispel the same doubts and fear that plague us through turbulent times of faith and doubt. Out of the impossible, the improbable, the mindboggling, and mysterious workings of God in our lives, the Lord works wonders among men to bring about our salvation. Let us respond like Joseph, who when confronted with the Revelation from the Lord, embraced it with devotion and zeal, dispelling his doubts and fears, and trusting in the mercy, salvation, and divine plan of God, even amid a trying situation.

*"Do not fear, Son of David!" said the angel in a dream, "for the child Mary carries is the Son of God Most High."*

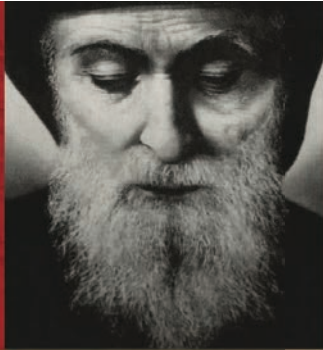
