**From the Desk of the Pastor**

The *mazmooro* of this Sunday prays,

*Zechariah was awestruck by the words of the watcher speaking to him in the sanctuary, and wonder and astonishment seised him because of the pregnancy of the barren one [sc. Elizabeth, Zechariah's wife].*

The Season of Announcements is a time of revelations and surprises but, also a time of new life. The revelations given to Zechariah, Mary, and Joseph tell us of God revealing His plan of salvation to three people who were not expecting to bear children, let alone a Prophet or Messiah.

We must ask ourselves during this holy season of preparation: how do we receive God's plan for us? Do we question and counter with resistance? Do we stick to our own preconceived notions and plans? Or do we, like Mary, accept God's will for us and participate fully and wholeheartedly?

God announces Himself in various ways - some subtle, some less so. In any case, it is our reaction to that Announcement that determines how God's plan is enacted in our lives. Let us always strive to be coworkers with God in His plan!

### Religious Education

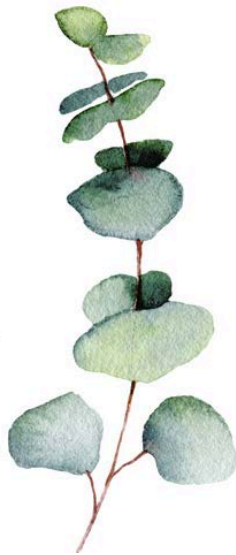

## Faith Formation

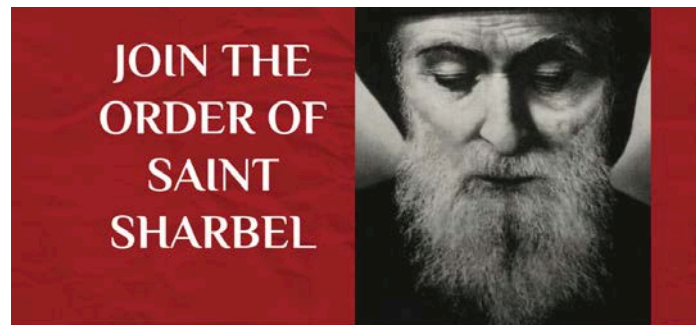
