
FOURTH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST

Pentecost the Church "with the prays Psalmist David" the great acclamation of the Resurrection Christ, "This is the Day the Lord has made; let us rejoice in it and be glad!"

In the longer version of this prayer the text elaborates further saying, "This is the Day that has no equal in the past nor in the future. This is the great Feast Day, Crown and Glory of all feasts!"

The Feast of the Resurrection of During the Sundays of Christ is so important that Easter Sunday by itself isn't enough. In fact, the whole Paschal Season isn't enough to fully appreciate the sacred event of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. So. for Christians, every single Sunday of the year is a "mini-Faster" where we again commemorate in the most solemn way Our Lord's Rising from the dead.


Second Collection






