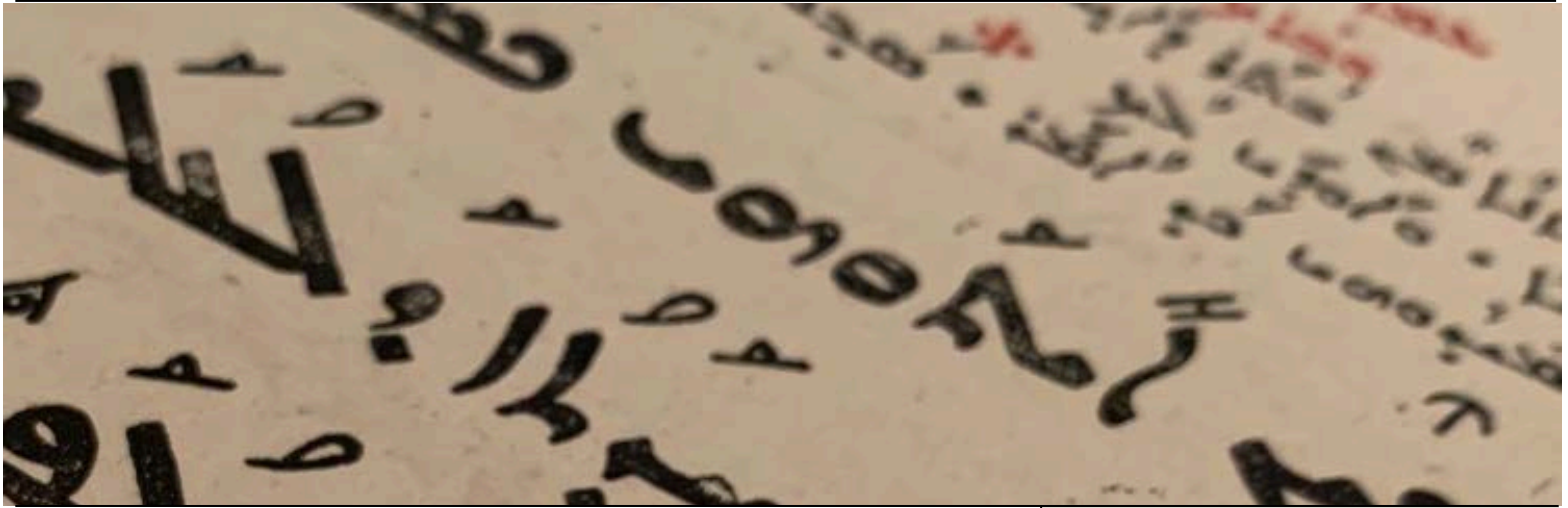


FOURTH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST



From the Desk of the Pastor

During the Sundays of Pentecost the Church prays “with the Psalmist David” the great acclamation of the Resurrection of Christ, “This is the Day the Lord has made; let us rejoice in it and be glad!”

In the longer version of this prayer the text elaborates further saying, “This is the Day that has no equal in the past nor in the future. This is the great Feast Day, Crown and Glory of all other feasts!”

The Feast of the Resurrection of Christ is so important that Easter Sunday by itself isn't enough. In fact, the whole Paschal Season isn't enough to fully appreciate the sacred event of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. So, for Christians, every single Sunday of the year is a “mini-Easter” where we again commemorate in the most solemn way Our Lord's Rising from the dead.

This great passion for the Gospel of our Lord's Resurrection is what inspired the Apostles, their Disciples, and all the Martyrs throughout the ages to give their lives for Christ. May we also be filled with the fervor of faith so that we might celebrate the Resurrection here at church and then spread of the Gospel of Christ throughout the world in our daily lives.

Second Collection

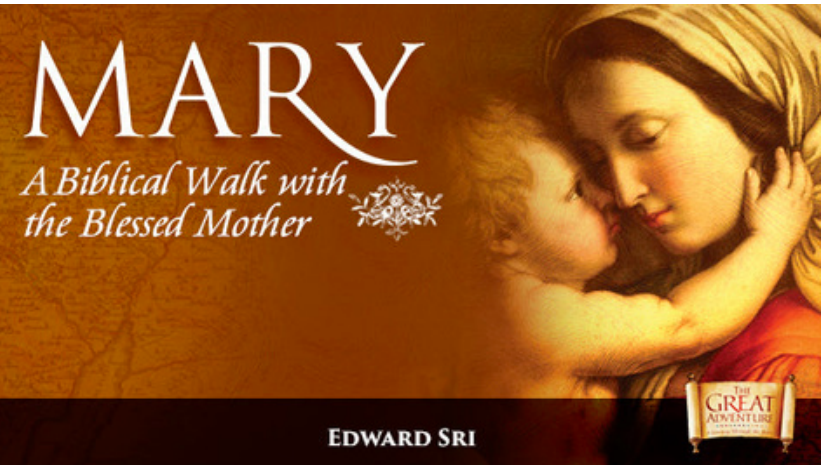
A second collection will be taken on **30 June** for the Holy Father.

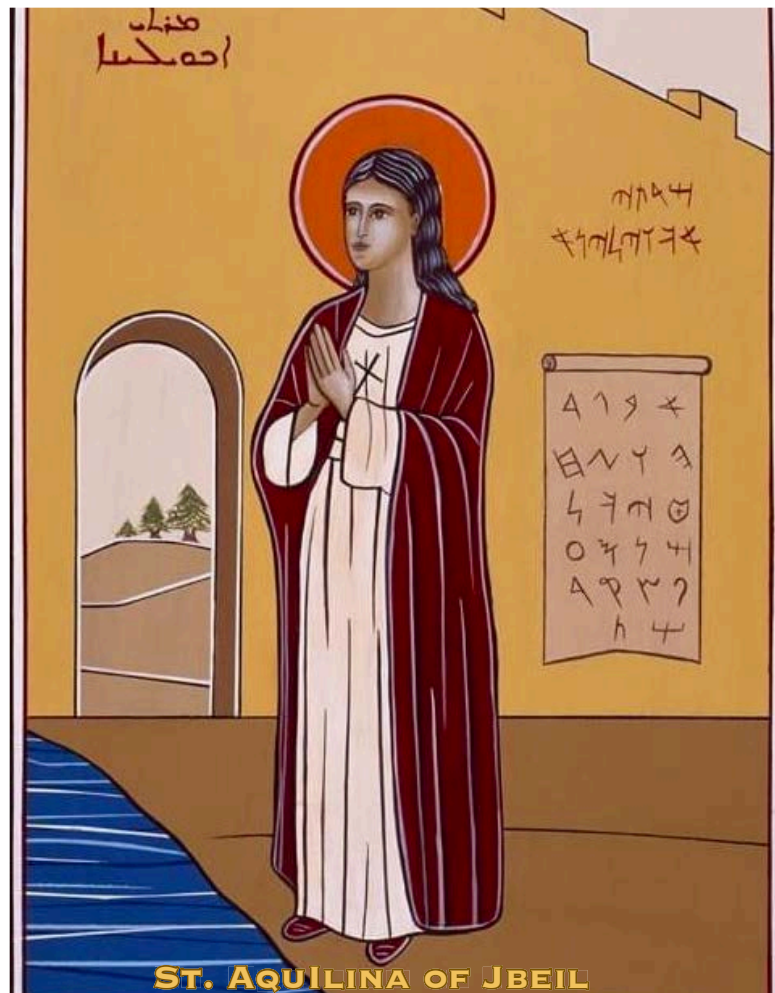

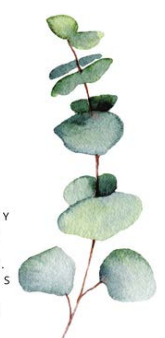
