The traditional Transfer Hymn for the feast of Easter sings:

Alleluia! Peace to those who are far and to those who are near, for Christ has risen from the grave and gathered those who were scattered. Peter believed, Thomas was assured, and sorrow has fled. Caiaphas hangs his head and the Sanhedrin mourns. Mary and her companions rejoice and sing praise. Alleluia, Our Gifts, Lord, receive!

The different characters from the Gospel narrative react to the Resurrection in many diverse ways. Peace was given to the peoples around the world who had been scattered and they have been gathered together as one Church. Peter, who had denied the Lord, now professes his belief in the Risen Lord. Thomas, who doubted is now assured and goes out with conviction. The disciples who were mourning and hiding in fear are now rejoicing and praising God. The high priest and his cohort who had conspired against Christ now mourn because Christ lives and the Church is born to spread the New Covenant throughout the world. How do we react to the wonder of the Resurrection? Let us join with Mary and her companions and sing praise! **Christ is Risen! Truly He is Risen!**

Breakfast

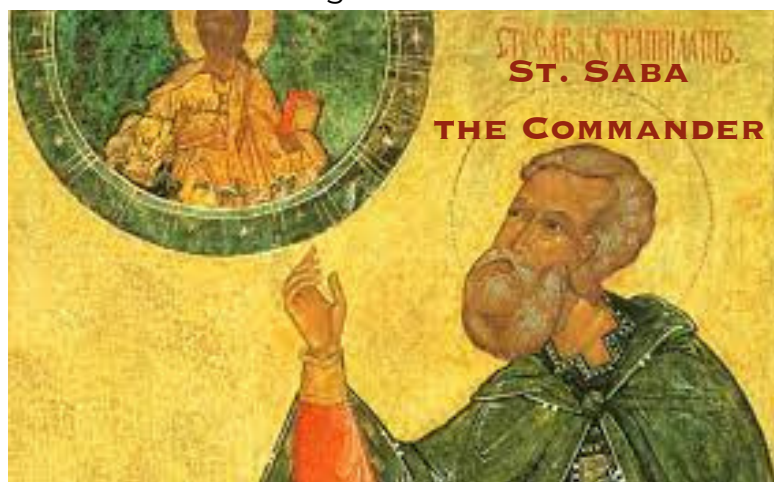
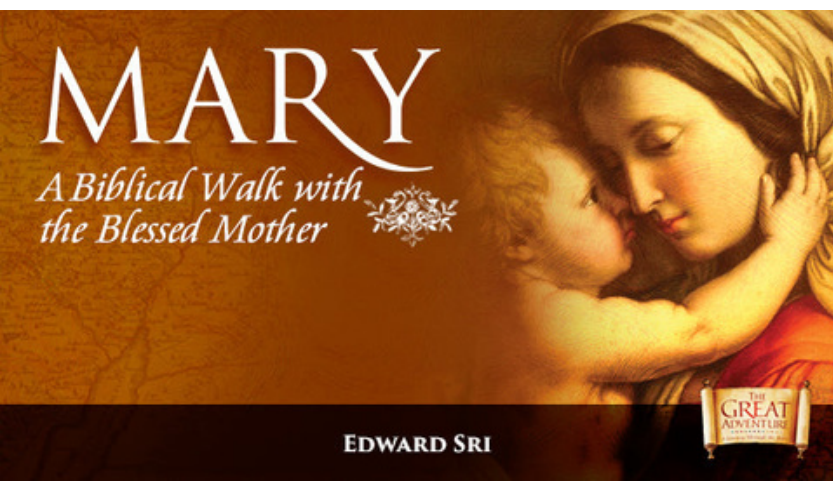
Please join us for **Breakfast** between the Sunday Liturgies on **Sunday, 21 April**. This breakfast is sponsored by **Donna George**.

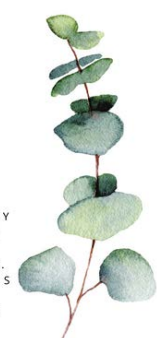
