

SUNDAY OF THE HEALING OF THE HEMORRHAGING WOMAN

**From the Desk of the Pastor**

The *bo'otho* for this Sunday's Liturgy paints for us a beautiful image of boldness and faith:

Blazing wings and wheels fear Him yet He is meek and when He was robbed among the crowd, He did not burn.

A fiery lance watchfully guards His treasures [ie Eden] yet a woman plundered Him, and he was quiet and did not rebuke her.

The hymn writer gives us two opposing images: the angelic hosts who shield themselves from the blazing and dreadful presence of the Throne of God and the boldness of the hemorrhagic woman who reaches out in faith to obtain healing and pardon from Jesus Christ. Also, we are confronted with the fiery sword that guards Paradise compared to the brazen touch of the woman who receives mercy and healing and not rebuke from the Lord.

The hemorrhagic woman is one of the most important models for a Christian – all of us are impure through our sin, yet we are promised that if we reach out to the Lord in repentance, just like the woman from the Gospel, the Door of Mercy will be opened to us. We can approach the blazing fire of God's love and mercy through the Sacraments with boldness, a boldness that the angels themselves do not enjoy. They hide themselves from the presence of God, where we, as Christian believers, boldly plunder the Treasures of our Lord and God and receive mercy and healing of soul and body.

During **Fridays of Great Lent**, **Confessions** will be heard from **6:00-6:30pm**. **Stations of the Cross** will be prayed at **6:00pm** followed by **Benediction of the Cross** at **6:30pm**.

Eparchial Charities Appeal

Lenten Fish Fry

Our **Lenten Fish Fry** returns during the **Fridays of Great Lent**. Lunch will be served from **11:00am-2:00pm** and Dinner from **4:00pm-6:00pm**. Preorders are available and **recommended**. More information will be available on our website and Facebook. We are also **in need of volunteers** to help work shifts.

Fasting

Fasting in the **Syriac Maronite tradition** consists of **abstaining from all meat, dairy products, and alcohol** from **Midnight until Noon Monday-Friday of Great Lent**. A light meal may be taken in the afternoon but without meat, dairy, or alcohol. Traditionally, fish is also excluded during Great Lent. Saturdays and Sundays are exempt from the Lenten Fast.

Easter Bourbon Raffle

We will host a **Bourbon Raffle** on Sunday, 31 March. **Tickets are \$25** and **only 250 tickets** will be sold. Tickets can be purchased through the **Parish Office** and **During the Lenten Fish Fry**. We are also **accepting donations** of bottles of Bourbon and Scotch for the Raffle!

Traditional Lenten Fasting

One meal is to be taken in the evening, or at least no food is to be taken from Midnight to Noon. Fasting is to be observed Monday to Friday. Saturday Fasting is only permitted on Great Saturday. No meat, meat products, dairy, or alcohol is to be taken. A vegan diet is to be observed.

Ash Monday, the Fridays of Lent, Great Friday of the Crucifixion

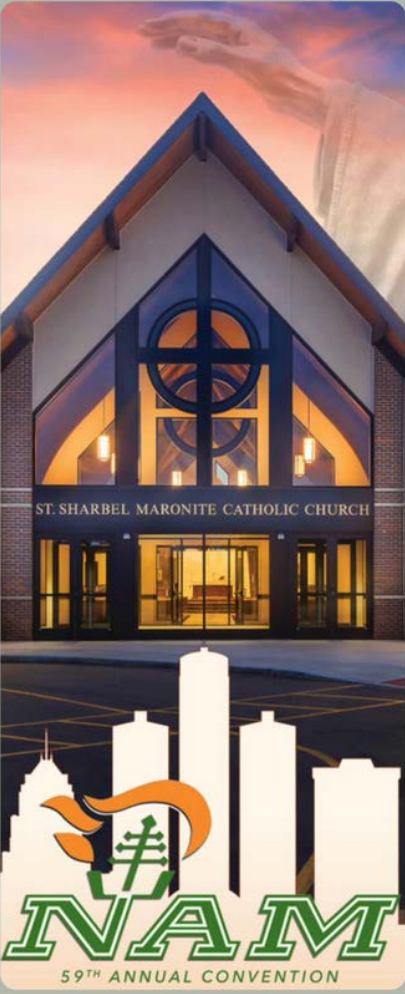
Egg Decorating Class
