
SECOND SUNDAY OF HOLY CROSS



From the Desk of the Pastor The Syriac Churches sing a hymn on Friday night that birth prays:

Adam instructed his children of what reason he and Eve were called to depart from Paradise. He spoke to them of his former authority and of his fall and his exile when he was shamed. It is not fitting for the foot that ran to the Tree to tread the Holy Place when it is not clean. It is not right for the hand that plucked the fruit in Eden to wave over the Offerina of the Lord. Christ, who came and walked on the earth and uprooted its thorns, by you Adam returned to Paradise.

Faith Formation



Blessing of Animals






