

SIXTH SUNDAY OF THE GLORIOUS RESURRECTION

**From the Desk of the Pastor**

The Maronite Church celebrates three months of the year in honor of the Mother of God: January for the planting of crops, May for the wheat harvest, and August for the grape harvest.

It is no coincidence that these agricultural celebrations in particular are tied to Mary, the Mother of God. We must recall that in the Transfer Hymn of the Maronite Liturgy we commemorate:

“Of the Virgin Mary I was born, taking flesh as man; as good earth receives a seed, her womb received me...” recalling that the Incarnate Christ is the Wheat which will become the Bread of Life in the Eucharist. Similarly, we commemorate Christ as the Fruit which was pressed upon the Vine of the Cross Whose Blood we receive in the Eucharist.

The role that Mary plays in the Incarnation also finds meaning in the Eucharist which is given to us by the Church. Let us renew our own reverence for the Holy Eucharist, asking for the intercession of Mary, Mother of God that we may always be made worthy to receive these most precious Gifts with devotion, humility, and adoration.

Gabriel Scholarship

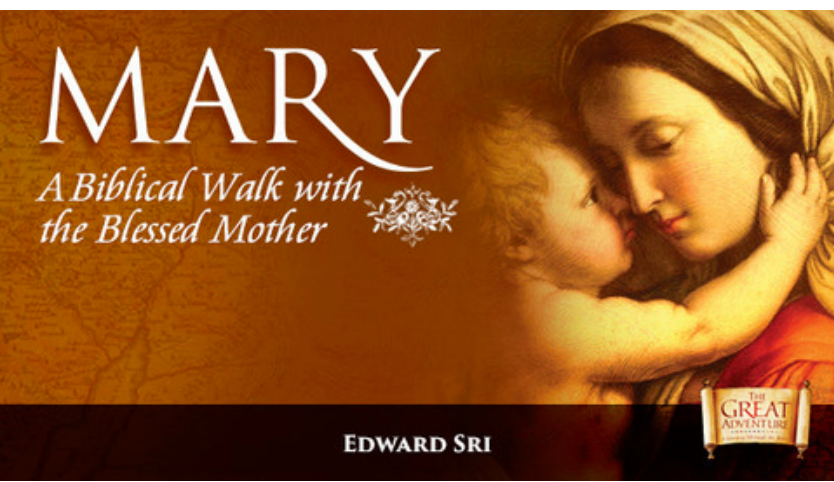

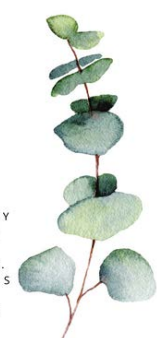
