From the Desk of the Pastor

In one of the concluding prayers of the Anaphora of St. Mark the Church prays: "Bless and forgive the priests who are the stewards of your people and of your holy Church. Forgive the deacons of your Divine Mysteries and all the faithful who have shared in this sacrifice." The Church prays that God should not only bless but forgive her priests and deacons. This is not only because these men are weak and sinful just as all humanity is weak and sinful, but also because the ordained clergy of the Church have been entrusted with the stewardship of the Father's Treasure House of Mysteries.

When a priest fails it is not only his own salvation that is risked, but the souls of all those under his stewardship and the sanctity of the sacred things he has been entrusted. Therefore, we not only pray for vocations to the priesthood, but we pray for our bishops, priests, and deacons to be preserved in true faith and holiness all the days of their lives, and we pray for our departed priests who struggled to live up to the dignity to which they had been called. We pray for all the dead, but we pray especially for our priests who have served at our altars.

We pray to God that "priests, who changed bread and wine into Your Flesh and Blood, now hold branches of praise as they meet You."

Nineveh Fast

The ancient and traditional three day **Nineveh Fast** or *Supplication of the Ninevites* begins on **Monday 22 Jan at Midnight and ends at Noon on Wednesday 24 January**. This strict fast commemorates the three days the Prophet Jonah spent in the belly of the sea beast and the subsequent repentance of the people of the city of Nineveh.

Feast of the Presentation

We will celebrate the **Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple** on **Friday, 2 February** at **8:30am** with the **Blessing of Candles**. Please bring any candles for your use throughout the year to liturgy this day for a blessing.

Memorials for the Departed

Your envelope packet will include a **memorial envelope for the Faithful Departed**. Please write the names of your beloved departed on them and return it in the collection. These names will be remembered during the **liturgies all of February**.

Stewardship

As outlined in the Letter from the Chancery that was included in the bulletin a few weeks ago, the **Eparchy is raising our monthly parochial assessment and our annual Lenten Bishop's Appeal**. Please prayerfully consider how you can help our parish to continue meeting our obligations to the Bishop and the Eparchy. Scripture tells us that ten percent of everything we have should be used for **the glory of God** and the **benefit of others**, and we suggest that 5% of your tithe be given to the parish in your offertory donations, 1% be given to the Eparchy in the Lenten Appeal, and the remaining 4% be given to charities of your choice including our capital campaigns and building fund.

Feast of St. Maron

We will celebrate the Feast of St. Maron with **Evening Prayer and Liturgy at 6:30pm** on **Thursday, 8 February** followed by a 'BYOB' *Khamis El Sakara* - "Drunkard's Thursday" **Cocktail Hour** before the Fast of Great Lent. Liturgy will also be celebrated at **8:30am on Friday, 9 February**. This is the Patronal Feast of our Maronite Church and a **Holy Day of Obligation**.

Second Collection

A second collection will be taken the weekend of **28 January** for the **USCCB Worldwide Charities**.

Bible Study

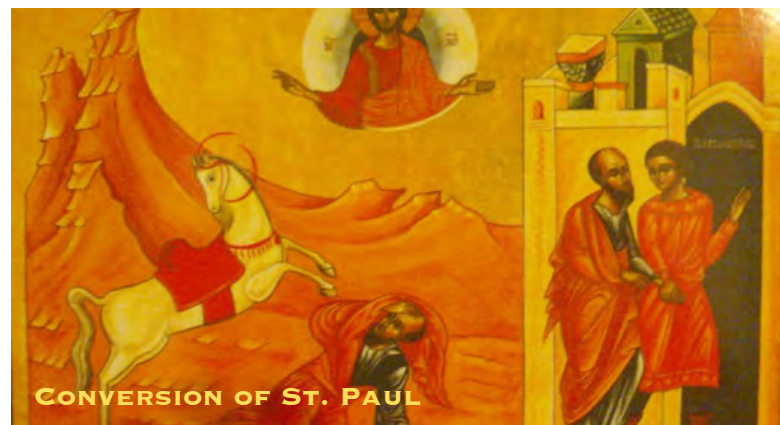
