

SUNDAY OF THE HEALING OF THE BLIND MAN

**From the Desk of the Pastor**

This week we reflect upon sight – in one respect we reflect upon natural sight and our relation to the created world around us. We are called to praise God along with all the created order – and we join that realm of creation through our senses. When we see the majesty of the mountains or the vastness of the sea, we approach the mystery of the magnitude of God. When we smell the fragrance of flowers and hear the calls of songbirds, we approach the mystery of the beauty of God, etc. When our senses are impaired our participation in the created order is limited.

By Christ restoring the sight of Bartimaeus, he restores to him a participation in the worship of God offered by all of creation.

The second respect of sight is of course an internal one – the “eye of the mind” and the “eye of the heart” spoken of so often by our Syriac Fathers. It is through our spiritual sightedness or our spiritual blindness that we either see or fail to see God, ourselves, and our own sinfulness. This blindness, however, is often self-inflicted and it requires effort on our part to open these internal eyes to gaze upon the Mystery of God once again.

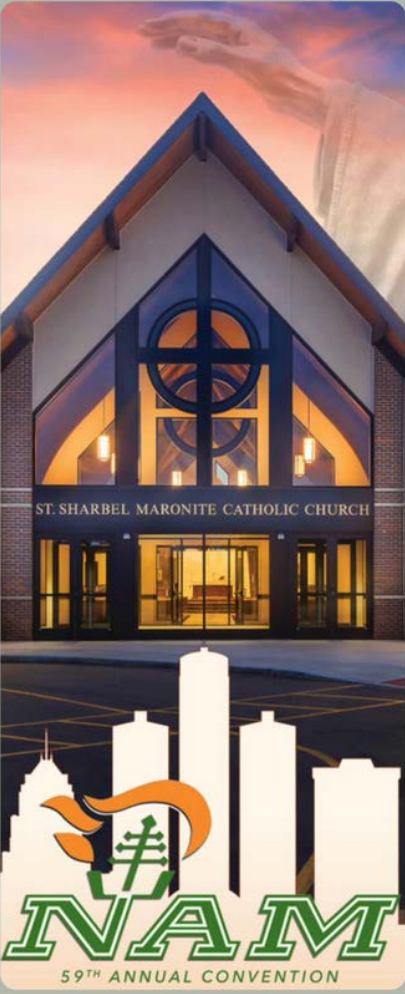
