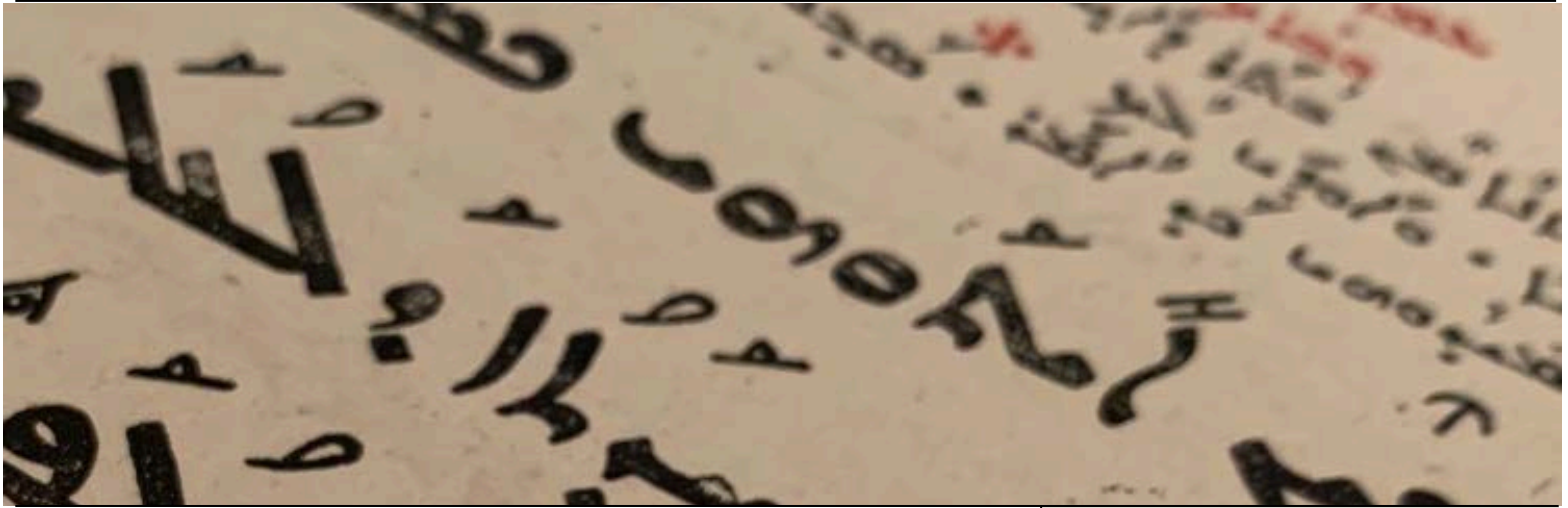


THIRD SUNDAY OF PENTECOST



From the Desk of the Pastor

In the communion hymn that is sung in dialogue between the priest and people there is a verse that beautifully prays, "May this pure sacrifice, O Lord, intercede for us at Judgment when we stand before Your great Throne!" This is a beautiful reminder that while the Holy Eucharist is nourishment for soul and body in the here and now, it is also a pledge of new life in the heavenly Kingdom.

The sacrifice offered upon the Table of Life in our churches "intercedes" for us at Judgment when we will all stand before the throne of God and answer for our deeds. The Holy Eucharist that nourished us in life will stand as an advocate for us in death. How can we not be reassured by this promise from our Lord!

This is also why the Church offers the Liturgy on behalf of the intentions of her faithful. This is most often seen through the offering of Forty Day Memorials, One Year Memorials, and the like. But the Liturgy can be offered for many other intentions – both for the dead and the living. I encourage you to make use of this great gift from the Church. Certain feast days must be offered by the pastor for the intentions of the parish as a whole but the other liturgies throughout the week are open to intentions. Please consider offering liturgies for your grandparents and parents, sick family members, or for special intentions known only to you.

If the Holy Sacrifice is the greatest gift the Church has to offer to the world, how can we not use the great gift of the Holy Eucharist to intercede before God on behalf of our loved ones and ourselves!

Food Festival

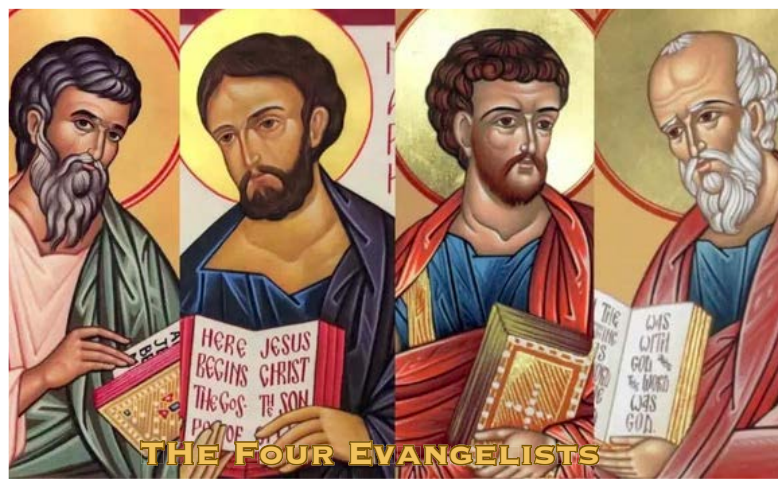
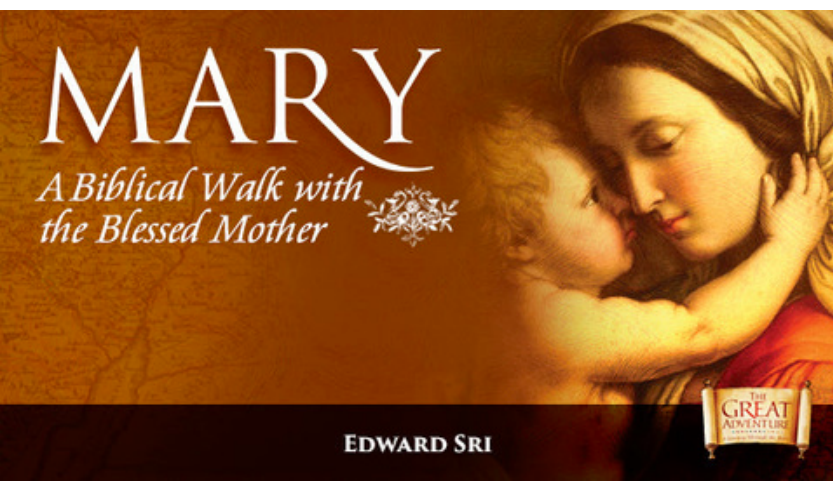

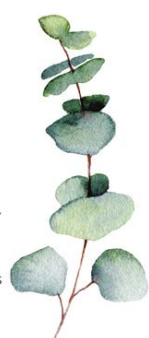
