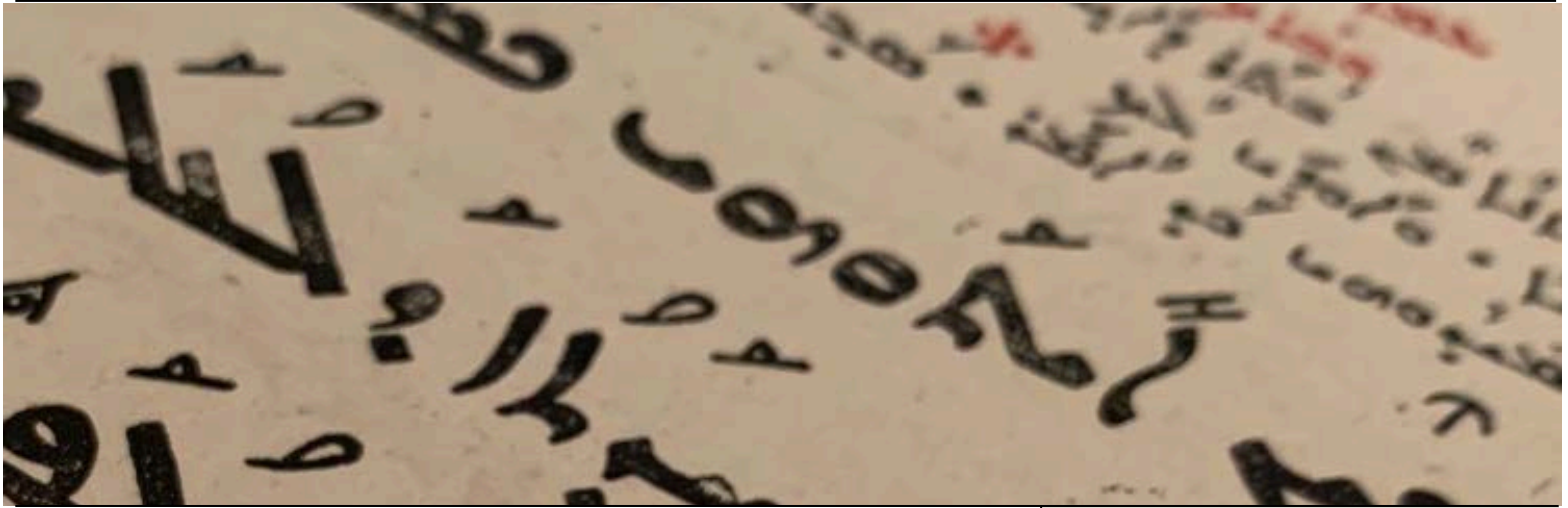


FEAST OF STS. PETER AND PAUL

**From the Desk of the Pastor**

Our Maronite tradition has several beautiful images that describe Saints Peter and Paul. "Peter and Paul are two temples, and in them dwells the Spirit of God the Word who became flesh. Peter and Paul are two jewels adorning the crown of the holy Church, the Bride of Christ. Peter and Paul are two strong pillars upon which the holy Church was built." Saints Peter and Paul serve as the two chief apostolic witnesses to the Christian faith and therefore give us profound examples to strive for in our own apostolic missions. We are called to become temples of God so that his presence may dwell within us and that we may offer him glory and worship throughout our lives. We are called to be precious jewels that adorn the crown of the Church, demonstrating the beauty of holiness that radiates throughout the world. We are called to be the foundation and support for the Church, upbuilding her mission, her character, and her identity in our own lives and through the work of the Church itself.

Peter and Paul were two flawed men who lived flawed lives and even amidst their apostolic mission these two found ways to fight with one another! Yet, despite their many flaws, Peter and Paul withstood great adversity, trials, and tribulations, and submitted themselves to martyrdom for the true faith. This gives us hope that despite our own flaws, our own misgivings, and our own mistakes we too can strive for lives worthy of the Christian calling and for deaths that give glory to the Incarnate Lord. May Saints Peter and Paul intercede for us that our own lives may be beautiful adornments on the raiment of Christ's holy Church.

Festival Preparation Days

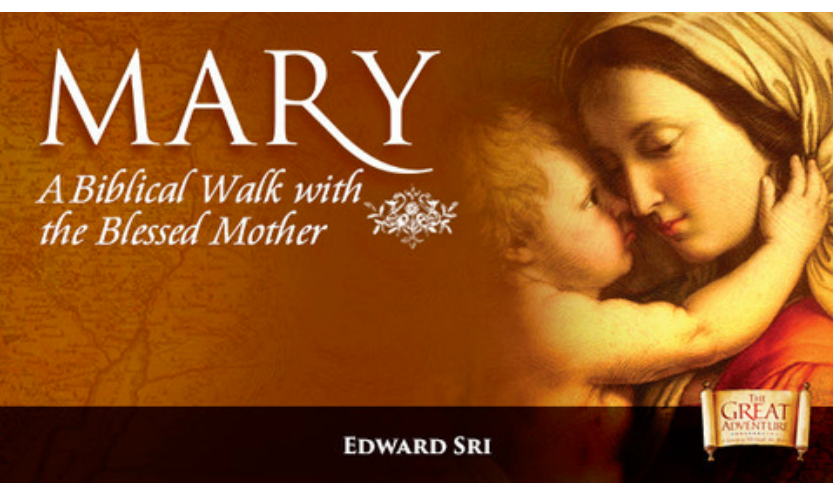

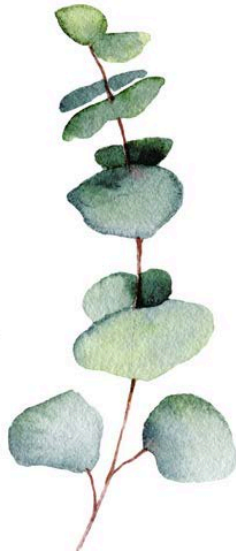
Collection Counters & Lectors
